

Now Open! Oak Cliff Senior Health & Wellness Center

A new 22,000 square-foot state-of-the-art health and wellness center serving adults age 60 and older in Oak Cliff opened last Fall under a co-operative venture between the City of Dallas and the non-profit WellMed Charitable Foundation (WCF).

The Oak Cliff senior focused health and wellness center is located at Camp Wisdom Road and US-67, at Red Bird Square.

The new Southwest Dallas center is adjacent to a WellMed primary care clinic, WellMed doctors, nurses and staff provide complimentary health care services, such as diabetes screenings and flu shots, to center members.





The new senior activity center will be the largest publicly funded facility of its kind in Dallas dedicated to seniors. The clinic will be the sixth WellMed-branded clinic in the Dallas-Fort Worth market. WellMed also operates more than 50 health care facilities in the region under the USMD brand.

Activities will include aerobics, walking clubs, weight training, bridge, dominoes, arts & crafts, book clubs, day trips, fitness and nutrition classes, volunteer opportunities, and more. The WCF will also introduce programs not found at other centers, such as healthy cooking classes in the demonstration kitchen, internet safety classes in a computer lab and caregiver support programs.




