myERF Has A New Look, New Features!

Not only has myERF been upgraded with a new look to make it easier for you to find what you need, but we have also added lots of new features!

Features of the new myERF portal include:

- Consolidated accounts for members who are active members and also receiving a pension from their spouse and retired employees who are also receiving a pension benefit from a deceased spouse. You will now be able to view both pensions under the same account
- You can now change your address in myERF!
- Upload and store documents in myERF
- Download your paystubs and 1099-Rs from myERF
- Access for more employees! In addition to active, retirees, and beneficiaries, deferred members will
 now be able to have a myERF account

ERF Board of Trustees Place 2 Election Results



The ERF Board of Trustees election for place 2 concluded on Thursday, October 22nd at 5pm. The regular election results are listed below.

VINCENT LEAL 126 votes
ZARIN GRACEY 175 votes
SUNIL KING 240 votes
DAVID LOPEZ 77 votes

Because no candidate received 50% or more of the vote, the Place 2 Trustee Election continued in a runoff election.

The two candidates with the highest percentage of the votes, Sunil King and Zarin Gracey, were eligible for the runoff election. Voting in the runoff closed Monday, November 9th, at 5pm.

ERF ONLINE CLASSES OFFERED IN 2021

ERF launched a new secure member portal in October of 2020. You may have already set up your new myERF account, but are you aware of all the new features? You can now change your address online. Let us know who your contacts are, like your doctor, attorney, family members, and more.

We will offer two sessions, both live and recorded, to ensure all members have access anytime, anywhere. We will hold live sessions in GoToWebinar from 11a - 1p with a live presentation and Q&A with the speaker, Re'Gine Green. Re'Gine has worked for ERF for over 15 years.

2021 Health Insurance Update

If you enrolled in the City of Dallas health insurance plan, you are enrolled in an employer-sponsored Blue Cross Group Medicare Advantage Open Access (PPO) health plan. This health plan is a custom plan that does not require a network provider for coverage. Your benefit levels are the same whether or not you use a network provider.

You may seek care from any provider nationwide that accepts Medicare. Please click here, https://dallascityhall.com/departments/human resources/DCH%20Documents/Baylor%20Scott%20%20White%20Health%20Notice.pdf. For the letter you will need to give your medical provider. The information included will help them understand your benefits.

Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Texas (BCBSTX) has a special agreement with Baylor Scott & White Health (BS&W) to provide services to City of Dallas retirees.

Here is what you need to know:

- You will need to show your BCBSTX member ID card each time you visit a BS&W facility.
- Your plan welcome kit includes a notice you will need to show to BS&W providers with the information they will need to bill the plan.
- Your providers can photocopy the notice to keep in your medical file, so you shouldn't need to take it with you every time you visit. You may also wish to take a photo of it on your mobile phone to have it handy, just in case.
- Finding a BS&W provider. To see a provider in this group, you can call 1.844. BSW.DOCS (1.844.279.3627).
- The BCBSTX Provider Finder®, will not show you BS&W providers. If you search the provider group's website, BCBSTX will not show as an available insurance plan option. If you have trouble locating a BS&W provider, call the numner listed about for assistance.
- If you currently have BS&W providers, be sure to tell them you are a City of Dallas retiree and show them your member ID card.
