Dallas ERF Investment Posted a Return of -4.43% in 2018

FROM THE DESK OF ERF'S EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, CHERYL ALSTON

Happy New Year!



The Employees' Retirement Fund of the City of Dallas ("ERF") investment portfolio generated a return of -4.43% (net of fees) for calendar year 2018 slightly ahead of the portfolio benchmark of -4.49%. Total assets under management decreased to \$3.27 billion in assets. The Fund has performed well over longer time periods. The Fund's 5-year return is 4.36% and the 10-year return is 9.72%.

The best performing asset class in 2018 was Private Equity. The private equity returns always lag a quarter behind so the last reported quarter is September 30, 2018. As of September 30, 2018, the investments in

Private Equity returned 15.11%. The Fund's Real Estate investments generated 1.09% for the year. The Real Estate investments consist of publicly traded real estate called Real Estate Investment Trusts ("REITs") as of December 31, 2018 and national private real estate funds as of September 30, 2018.

Global Low Volatility return was -3.38% underperforming the benchmark MSCI ACWI Minimum Volatility index of -1.56%. Global Equity earned -9.28% vs the MSCI ACWI of -9.42%. ERF's Domestic Equity portfolio earned -8.67% and our investment in International Equity had a return of -17.3% for 2018. Public Real Assets consists of energy Master Limited Partnerships (MLPs). The MLPs earned -11.01% vs the Alerian MLP benchmark of -12.42%.

Fixed Income is 30% of the ERF investment portfolio. Our investment in Global Fixed Income posted a return of -0.38% and underperformed the Bloomberg Aggregate benchmark of 0.01% in 2018. Our High Yield investments posted a return of -3.09% and the Opportunistic Credit posted a return of -2.12%. 2018 was a difficult year for the stock market with uncertainty in monetary policy and geopolitical events. I want to thank the Board members for their discipline, patience, and investment expertise as the markets continue to evolve. As pension fund investors, we have to remember to focus on the long term investment horizon. I would also like to take this opportunity to commend the ERF staff for their diligence and commitment to excellent service to employees and pensioners.

In summary, active members, terminated employees with a vested pension and retirees should feel confident that ERF remains sound and your retirement benefits are safe and secure. We welcome your questions, comments, or suggestions.

In our continuous effort to improve service to our members, we are pleased to announce that we have issued ERF Membership Cards to our retired members. Your card is unique to you and can be a handy resource to use when communicating with ERF.

Please note that your name and unique account number are printed on the front of the card. Your account number will be helpful when calling the myERF help desk number at 214-580-7738 for assistance accessing your online pension account. To get assistance for any other pension related questions, please call 214-580-7700.

HELPFUL TIPS:

When you call ERF, please be ready to provide your account number (found on your membership card), social security number, and date of birth.

Keep this card in your wallet or another safe, convenient place.

You can use this card at City of Dallas Recreation Centers to get a discount on membership.

Make sure we have your correct address.

To verify the address, we have for you log into your myERF account and view the address on your pay stub or your 1099R.

- 2. Click on "Change of Address Form"
- 3. Fill out the form
- 4. Print the form
- 5. Sign and mail the form to ERF
