

Time to Vote for Your Representative on the ERF Board

The Employees' Retirement Fund (ERF) is governed by a seven-member board of trustees, three of whom are elected by employees. This year ERF has had two trustee positions open for election to the Board. In April, John Jenkins, Assistant Director of Parks & Recreation was elected by employees to the ERF board. The second election is for the trustee employee position currently held by Tina Richardson.

Employee voting began on Tuesday, October 20, at 8am and will end on Tuesday, November 3, at 5pm. Election ballots were mailed to the home address you have listed in Lawson.

The 2015 ERF Trustee Nominating Committee was recalled and met on Monday, October 5. The committee nominated two candidates; **Theresa O'Donnell**, Management Services and **Tina Richardson**, Street Services.

What It Means to Be an ERF Trustee

Trustees set policy and give the Fund its direction. Three of the seven Trustees that make up the board of ERF are elected by the membership, three are appointed by the City Council and the seventh member is the City Auditor, ex officio.

As fiduciaries, each of the Trustees' decisions must be guided by the obligation to administer the Fund for the exclusive benefit of the members, retirees, and beneficiaries.

It is necessary for Trustees to become knowledgeable in areas of investment, management, actuarial policy and benefits administration.

Employee Contributions Increase to 13.32%



On October 1, 2015 the City of Dallas civilian employee contribution rate to the Employees' Retirement Fund increased from 13.06% to 13.32%, an increase of .26%.

An example of how the increase might effect you is an employee with a bi-monthly gross pay of \$2,000 at the 13.06% contribution rate contributed \$261.20 per pay period. With the new contribution rate, that employees' contribution rate would increase by \$5.20 per pay period.

Keep Track of Your Pension Benefits with ERF's Online Portal

ERF has created an online portal called **myERF**. The portal is a secure online tool for you to access your benefit statement 24/7. The current statement available on the portal was last calculated as of **June 30, 2015**. Our next goal is to provide you an updated statement every month by the Spring of 2016.

The portal also provides education about your benefits including disability benefits, pension calculation and retirement eligibility. To date over 2,000 employees are registered users of myERF. Our

goal is that all employees contributing to the Fund will register on the portal to review their benefit statements and learn more about their pension benefits.

You can register by visiting www.dallaserf.org, clicking the myERF button and then registering for an account. Keep in mind when registering your employee number must be six digits. If it is not, add leading zeros. For example, if your employee number is 12345, you should enter 012345.
